Plymouth WI Ordinance: SEC. 11-2-18 CONDUCT AND OPERATORS OF PARADE UNITS: (a) No person shall, throw, dispense or give away any throw, dispense or similar giveaways from any parade vehicle, float or unit. (b) Any operator of a motorized vehicle, float or unit shall have a valid driver's license. Any operators of an all-terrain vehicle, electric personal assistive device, golf cart or lawnmower shall be at least 14 years of age. Any tractor operator shall be at least 14 years of age and hold an applicable operator safety certificate.
