**P.O.W./M.I.A.:** Gene Blindauer reported the following recoveries for proper burial: US Army; 2 South Korea, 3 North Korea, 2 Germany, 1 Netherlands, 2 France, 1 Austria, US Marines 3 Tarawa, and 2 US Navy Pearl Harbor. He also reported that 55 unidentified remains have been turned over from North Korea, however 5,300 still remain unaccounted for from North Korea. A remembrance of the Missing in Action will take place at Plymouth City Hall Flag pole Saturday September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 8:00 AM.
